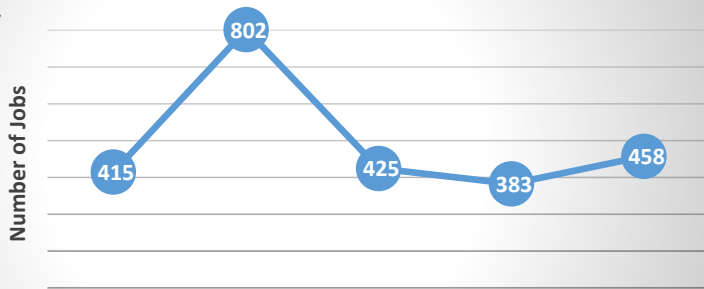


## KY Statewide EPSCoR 2012 – 2017

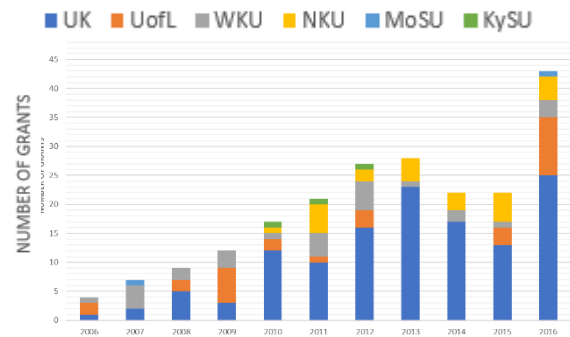
## KY NASA EPSCoR
